Residential sales statistics released by the Ann Arbor Area Board of Realtors show continued stability in the market. Year-to-date figures for sales and dollar volume exceed those from last year by 10%. Condo sales for October were up 25% over last year, while single family residential units were down 23% from October 2009. The average residential sales price remains relatively unchanged at \$183,831.

According to Lawrence Yun, Chief Economist for the National Association of Realtors, existing-home sales are forecast to gradually rise, with some occasional dips along the way. "For 2011 we should see more than 5.1 million existing-home sales, up from about 4.8 million this year. Housing starts are expected to rise to 716,000 in 2011 from 598,000 this year," Yun said. "We've added 30 million people to the U.S. population over the past 10 years, but sales are where they were in 2000, so there appears to be a sizable pent-up demand that could come to the market once the economy gathers momentum."
